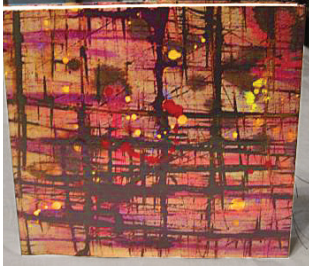
WATERCOLOR ▶ WITH Sandy Kowallis SATURDAY, JAN 14 • 10AM-2PM

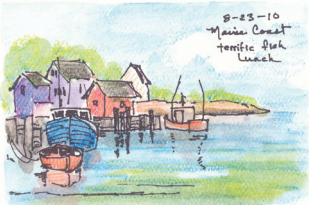
▶ BOOKMAKING WITH Kim Elia SATURDAY, JAN 21 • 10AM-2PM

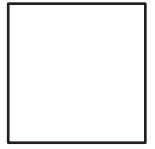

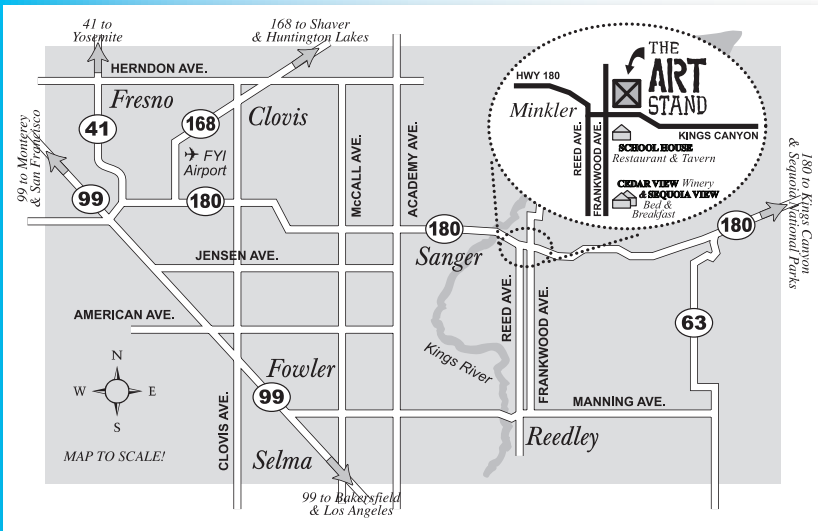
